The STAR programme includes annual assessments for •Reading and mathematics, grades 3–8 • Writing at Grades 4 and 7 • Science at Grades 5 and 8 •Social studies at Grades 8 • End-of-course assessments for English I, English II, Algebra I, biology and American history. Starting in 2016, TEA will voluntarily administer STAR EOC assessments for English III and Algebra II. A test form is a set of released test questions previously administered to Texas students that reflect the STAR test blueprints. TEA will release the first test form administered in the spring for each general STAR assessment in 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 and every third year thereafter.
